Look & Feel - SORTIMO Speedwave at the Caravan Salon

Premiere at Düsseldorf!

That's what we call accelerating: only last year SORTIMO Speedwave made its successful debut at the exhibition stands of VW and DaimlerChrysler. And already this year SORTIMO Speedwave will present its refreshingly innovative and useful (leisure time) ideas for more comfortable and functional in-vehicle design in Hall 16, Stand No. 16 D74/02.

1. The new mobile Speedwave OUTDOOR-MODULES

Thanks to the spacious large-capacity sedans from VW and Mercedes Benz (VW T5 Multivan, MB Viano), your vacation will be a very comfortable one. With these "Rolling Homes" and MiniVans in mind Speedwave has developed **flexible** and **self-sufficient Outdoor Modules** which are fixed to the standard seating rails by means of an adapter plate. Enjoy your evening dinner with the Speedwave **Outdoor Module „Cooking and Dish Washing“**. A pretty smart mini kitchen with heat-resistant glass cover. Easy cooking is made possible by a two-flame camping stove. Also integrated is a stainless steel sink with electric water supply. Underneath the sink and stove is a 1.4 kg CAMPINGAZ-gas bottle and two tanks with a 12 liter capacity for fresh water and drain water. The fresh water canister has an integrated electric pump. Between gas bottle and canisters is sufficient storage room for camper accessories such as kitchenware and supplies. The **Outdoor-Module Cooling** has a 33 l compressor cold box which assures cool drinks at all times. The versatile M-Box beneath the cold box is especially suitable for mobile use. The very lightweight and sturdy with practical handle is a must for all leisure time connoisseurs.

Both Outdoor Modules can be closed by means of innovative **shutters**. Available colors range from bright and trendy to classical. You have the choice between blue, silver or orange. Added textile bags are simply ideal for storing smaller items. Both **Speedwave Outdoor Modules** are **easy to remove** without any tools via an adapter plate and can also be used outside or in the awning. And you will have no problem parking them in your garage at home.

2. The universal pull-out loading platform by SORTIMO Speedwave

One of the more important highlights for interior designers is the moment of surprise. The idea to make loading fun while avoiding a backache has been realized brilliantly by the Speedwave engineers, i.e. a rather **smart loading system uniting comfort and everyday suitability for service with safety and functionality**. The loading platform can be pulled out in two stages and fulfils many hobby and leisure time requirements. Use it for your heavy shopping bags or as a helpful support for your baggage or bike. Because thanks to several lashing points you can store up to 125 kg on it – without getting a backache. As an accessory module it can be retrofitted and based on flexible widths and depths it can be used in a variety of vehicle models. And by now this “weight-bearing capacity idea” is classified as a valuable extra among car manufacturers.

3. Bürstner recreational vehicle with rear garage system „all-on-board“

SORTIMO Speedwave has developed a rear garage system for the rear of campers. This “poor cousin” inside the vehicle gains much functionality by the **all-on-board system**. Because we’ve integrated a light-weight rack system which includes shelf trays and sturdy but light plastic boxes – our S- and M-boxes. The shelf trays store everything the camper needs: water canister, sunshades or rubber boots. The boxes are ideal for storing smaller camping utensils whereby the the box can be removed from the rack and carried easily as a tote box by using the handle. An additional lashing strap with lock buckle secures the spare wheel. This „made-to-measure-suit“ in the rear of the camper guarantees order, efficiency and safety. And now with everything under control you can really enjoy your camping trip.

4. The in-vehicle Manager - Experiment mobile Office

SORTIMO Speedwave had the idea of equipping vehicles with a mobile office. "Because today's vehicles have to be "all-purpose vehicles" – says Managing Director Reinhold Braun. The Speedwave think tank also developed a so-called in-vehicle manager, a **sturdy multi-functional box on the passenger seat**. Also integrated is a notebook tray which can be moved over to the driver's side and the flexible interior for the printer and mains adaptor. And of course also suitable for storing folders and business papers.
